  - Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy
  - Vestibular Rehabilitation
- Demonstrated strong interest in Clinical Pilates or similar active rehabilitation methods, as evidenced by:
  - Completion of relevant professional development, or
  - Experience teaching Clinical Pilates or similar classes, or
  - Enrolment in upcoming relevant training and a clear intent to develop Pilates/exercise leadership skills.
- Description of any other physiotherapy skills or experiences that would enhance Through Life Physiotherapy's services and align with our values and community focus.
